

ICC2015 ORIENTEERING COMPETITION

GUIDELINES

RULES AND TECHNICAL ISSUES

I. DATE & PLACE:

Date : 26th August 2015
Place : Fundão Island –UFRJ – Rio de Janeiro, RJ - Brazil

II. CATEGORIES :

Categories for Male and Female Competitors	Circuit
“A” Professional/ Standard level	Circuit A : 4.5 km (long run)
“B” Amateur level	Circuit B : 1.5 km (short run)

III. GENERAL FEATURES OF THE COMPETITION:

1. Regulations of the International Orienteering Federation currently in force will be applied.
2. The orienteering event will consist of one (01) race.
3. In each of the 2 categories, the winner is determined by the time achieved during the race.
4. The competitors will start at the beginning of the race at different times, at regular 2-minute intervals.

IV. PRIZES:

1. Award recognition:
To the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place, by category (A and B), male and female.
2. Certificates:
For all those registered in the competition.

PARTICIPANTS:

All people registered as attendees in the Cartographic Conference organized by the Brazilian Society of Cartography are entitled to participate.

Students of the Federal University of Rio de Janeiro will be entitled to participate, but will not compete against ICC attendees.

V. DISQUALIFICATION:

Participating athletes will be disqualified if they:

1. Do not comply with the rules established for the competition at any moment of its performance.
2. Fail to finish the whole route of the race within the maximum time set and confirmed in the technical meeting previous to the competition.

3. Fail of monitoring at any of the control points.
4. Lose or not to return the chip at the reception or checking desks.
5. Obtain or provide technical assistance at any moment during the race.

VI. NECESSARY EQUIPMENT:

All the registered attendees should arrive at the start of the competition equipped with appropriate clothes (cap) and sun protection.

All other equipment, such as compass, chip, numbers, identification, will be provided by the organizers.

VII. GENERAL SCHEDULE:

25th August - 16:00 hs: Preparatory Meeting - CCSA

26th August - 15:30 hs: Transportation to UFRJ.

The transportation will leave the Conference Venue after the first afternoon oral session.

- 16:00 hs: Technical Meeting.
- 16:10 hs: Start of Race.
- 17:00 hs: End of Race.
- 17:15 hs: Final Meeting
- 17:30 hs: Transportation to CCSA.

VIII. ADMINISTRATIVE ISSUES:

All services will be provided by the organizers:

1) Food and Drink: Fruits, water and other drinks;

2) Health: All health services will be also provided by the organizers. At the competition site, one doctor, 2 nurses and two ambulances will be available for attendance.

NOTE: If the need for more substantial medical aid arises, the patient will be moved to one of the nearby Municipal Hospital.
